

Family Ministry

Over the past year, Journey Family Ministries, encompassing both Journey Kids and Journey Student Ministries, has significantly impacted the next generation here at Journey of Faith. Journey Kids provided a nurturing environment where children learned about God's love through engaging Bible lessons, crafts, and games, fostering faith and friendships. Journey Kids has also hosted fun family events,

Kids Camp, and taken kids to Hume Lake. 
