# Ponderosa & Meadow Ranch

- Camp costs **\$1090 per student**. This cost includes transportation to and from camp, housing, meals, and a camp t-shirt while at Hume Lake. It also helps to cover the cost of our amazing counselors!
- In order to secure a spot, you must register your student for camp online with Journey of Faith. When registering, you will have the option of paying in full or making monthly payments.
- If you choose to make payments, a required, \*non-refundable \$100 deposit will be due at registration on January 17, and must be paid via credit or debit card.



# All Camp Information

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## General Store- Ponderosa & Meadow Ranch

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The General Store supplies snacks, toiletries, apparel, and much more! In case your camper mis-places or forgets to bring a camp necessity, they can most likely find it at the General Store. **We recommend sending your camper with \$80 - \$100 for the week.**

## Trading Post-Wagon Train

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The Trading Post supplies only crafts and snacks for purchase during free time 2-5pm daily. It **does not supply camper personal items** like toothbrushes or toothpaste. Money for additional snacks and crafts may be added to the camper account through the Hume Lake registration page. **We recommend \$20.00 for the week** (Which you can upload to their account through Hume Lake). Kids will have the chance to purchase a large camp photo for \$6.

## Weather

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Hume is usually warm, there are hot days but the temperature does drop! It doesn't usually rain, but it can so be prepared!

## Email

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When you register with Hume Lake, you will have the option to sign up to send your camper emails. Please note: Your camper will not be able to send you any in return.

# All Camp Information Cont.

## Mail

You may send your camper packages mail/packages while they are at camp. Mail is distributed daily, Monday - Friday after dinner. It takes longer than normal to deliver packages to Hume, so please plan to mail 5 days in advance of when you would like your student to receive their package. If you want to send multiple cards/packages please include on the front the day that you would like them to be delivered (otherwise they will all be delivered at one time).

## Phones

There is no cell reception at Hume Lake. This is a great time for students to disconnect from electronic devices. They will not need their phones during this trip as ETA and arrival info will be communicated back to you by one of our staff members. Students can easily lose or break their phone while at camp, so if possible, leaving their phones at home would be best. We encourage a distraction-free week for our campers!

There are pay phones at Ponderosa & Meadow Ranch, but not at Wagon Train.

# All Camp Information Cont.

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## Medical

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- A doctor and a nurse are provided for each week of camp
- There is a volunteer fire department on-site
- There are two on-call EMT staff daily
- There is a fully-stocked First Aid station with 24-hour access to counselors
- A registered nurse administers and ensures all daily medications are given to campers.
- Hume's Emergency number is (800) 965-4863 x0

**\*If there are any discipline issues or health reasons that necessitates your child leaving camp, you will be required to pick your child up from Hume Lake on the day you've been notified.**

## Camper Medication

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- You will need to register every kind of medicine that your camper will have with Hume (including allergies and pain relievers).
- On the day of departure, you will need to place your student's medication **IN ITS ORIGINAL CONTAINER** and place it in a Ziplock bag. Write the camper's name, church name, and camp name on the bag.
- Turn in the medication to the Check-In table on the day of departure.
- If your student carries a rescue inhaler or an epi-pen, please check those in as well. They will be handed back to your student to keep with them once the nurse logs them in.

## Camper Food Allergies

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- Note: Hume's procedures for handling special dietary needs is part of the Hume registration process. You will need to register all food allergies with Hume Lake so that they are able to accommodate any dietary needs
- Also, please mention all food allergies to your student's counselor at the Hume Lake Health Screening.
- Due to the increased volume of special diet requests, increased costs of special diet food, and increase in labor to create and prepare special diet menus, Hume will add a surcharge of \$50 to camp menus where Hume is providing substitutions and special food preparation.

## Hume Lake App

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- Hume Lake launched an app this year. It's just "Hume Christian Camps" in the app store. To login, you will use the same email/password you used to register your campers, don't create another account.
- If you would like to send your camper emails, you must do so by downloading the app, and purchasing an email package through "Bunk1"
- If you'd like to view photos of your camper throughout the week taken by Hume staff, you will need to download the app and login to your existing account to view their galleries.

# Hume Lake Health Screening

- Before we leave for camp, **every camper and counselor are required to pass a Health Screening** to ensure that they are not sick before coming to camp. This must be done 24 hours before we leave and is to be completed at the Health Screening.
- The Health Screen will be **Saturday, July 11 at 8am for Wagon Train, 9am for Meadow, and 9:30am for Ponderosa.**
- In addition to the health screening, the campers will have the opportunity to meet the other counselors and campers in their cabin.

# Hume Lake Departure

- Hume Lake Departure is at the **South Bay Galleria (1815 Hawthorne Blvd, Redondo Beach, CA 90278)** parking lot on **Sunday, July 12**. Check-in at 8:00am, SHARP.
- If you have purchased Dramamine for your child, they will receive it at departure check-in. On the morning that we return, your child will be given the Dramamine at Breakfast.

# Hume Lake Arrival

- Hume Lake Pick-up will be in the lower lot at **Journey of Faith's Manhattan Beach Campus on Saturday, July 18 around 4pm.**
- A staff member will be texting/emailing you when we get close to JOF so make sure your number is on the consent/release form.

**Register online with full payment or \$100 deposit.**

**Stay up to date on camp payments monthly.**

**Look for registration code email from Hume Lake to finalize your registration**

**IMPORTANT:** In May, you will receive an email from Hume Lake with a Request Code. You must log on to your Hume Lake account and register your student with Hume. You will only receive a Request Code from Hume Lake if you have registered with Journey of Faith first and your payment balance is up to date.

## **Health Screening**

Look for information on and plan to attend the camp health screen on July 11, starting at 8am in the E-Rooms (Journey of Faith, 1243 Artesia Blvd. Manhattan Beach, CA 90266) to get camp information during the parent informational meeting and so that your camper can complete a health screening. **Health Screening is mandatory before attending camp.**
